The School Day

Our school day is set up to maximise learning opportunities, both in terms of basic skills and wider curriculum content and experiences. Generally, children work in lessons that last no more than 1 hour. Most lessons are split up into smaller parts so that children complete a number of tasks across a lesson.

Start and finish times, as well as timetable content, vary across school depending on which phase and class your child is in.

Nursery sessions operate as follows:

Morning session: 8:45-11:45

Afternoon session: 12:15-3:15

For reception children, school starts at 8:50 am and ends at 3:00 pm.
