# RAINBOW READS

In Reception and KS1, our home reading books are closely matched to the phonics the children have learnt that week. These books (Read Write inc 'Book Bag Books') are decodable to consolidate sounds and develop fluency. **These are for your child to read to you!** Your child may also bring home a non-decodable reader for enjoyment. This is a book to share with your child at home but may not match your child's phonics ability.

The school promotes a 'reading for enjoyment' ethos. Giving children lots of opportunities to read stories within lessons, assemblies and in reading corners.

SWANS RAINBOW READS are books chosen by your child weekly, to bring home and share at home in Nursery, Reception and Year 1.

**This is a book for you to read to your child!**

So what happens next?...

- Your child will bring home a folder with a chosen book every Friday or Wednesday (Nursery).
- Children will swap the book in class (or during early morning reading) on a Friday or Wednesday.
- Each week, sign the dated box to say that you have read the book (you can read the book more than once but only 1 signature is required.)
- Bookworm bookmarks and prizes will be given every time 3 books have been read (so that's a prize every 3 weeks).
